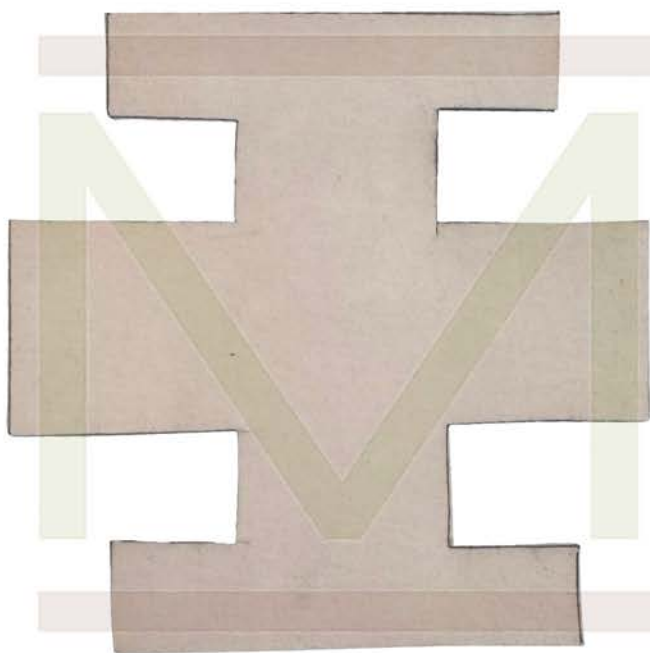

FOLD-A-BOWL INSTRUCTIONS

(Using SlabMat Templates)

What you'll need

- Rolled clay slab
- SlabMat Fold-A-Bowl template
- Needle tool or knife
- Slip and scoring tool

Steps:

1. Roll clay to an even thickness.
2. Place the SlabMat template flat on the slab.
3. Cut cleanly around the outside edge of the template.
4. Remove excess clay, leaving the cut shape.
5. Gently fold the flaps or sections upward to form the bowl or container.
6. Score and slip where pieces overlap.
7. Press seams together and smooth joins.
8. Let the piece firm up before refining edges or adding details.

Why SlabMat works great for templates:

SlabMat is rigid enough to cut around without bending or deforming, and durable enough to be used over and over again. It stays flat on the slab, holds its shape, and makes consistent results easy—perfect for template work and classroom projects!
